On Saturday, December 16 at 11:00 AM, The Daughters of the American Revolution and the Daughters of the Confederacy will come to Grace to honor those who gave their lives in the service of our country with the Wreaths Across America.

Each December on National Wreaths Across America Day, our mission to Remember, Honor and Teach is carried out by coordinating wreath-laying ceremonies at Arlington National Cemetery, as well as at more than 2,500 additional locations in all 50 U.S. states, at sea and abroad. Wreaths will be placed on each grave of veterans who fought in the wars to protect our freedoms. There will be full military honors and a brief order of prayers and commemoration. Wreaths Across America's mission touches the lives of thousands of school, scout, civic and religious groups across the country through wreath sponsorships. These groups help us ensure that we reach our goal to place a wreath on each hero's grave. Because this is a national event, many people not connected to Grace will hopefully be in attendance on December 16. The Grace Cemetery is listed on the national website for Wreaths across America as one of the 1,200 locations taking place on December 16 for this ceremony. This will be a wonderful witness to the Grace Congregation and Cemetery Ministry.

The Grace congregation will be hosts to all who come as we will serve coffee, hot chocolate, cookies and doughnuts in Union Church following the Rite of Commemoration. Grace disciples are urged to help host with the serving coffee and refreshments. Contact Herb Travis is you are willing to help.
