TRANSFIGURATION OF JESUS CHRIST FEBRUARY 11, 2024

TRANSFIGURATION OF JESUS CHRIST was an important moment in the life of Jesus and the evidence of His divinity. Jesus performed a series of miracles and foretells His own death. Afterwards, Jesus led just three of his disciples, Peter, James and John, to a high mountain, which is where the Transfiguration took place, and his appearance was radiantly transformed.

SHROVE TUESDAY PANCAKE SUPPER TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 13TH AT 6:00 PM FELLOWSHIP HALL

The expression "Shrove Tuesday" comes from the word, "shrive," which means to confess and receive absolution. Historically, it was the custom to confess sins before Lent. The day gets its name from the tradition of Christians trying to be "shriven" before Lent. In other parts of the world such as the US and Australia, Shrove Tuesday is known as Mardi Gras, which is French for "Fat Tuesday."

ASH WEDNESDAY WORSHIP WITH IMPOSITION OF ASHES FEBRUARY 14TH AT 7:00 PM

Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of Lent, a 40-day season of fasting, reflection and remembrance before the Holy Week and resurrection of Jesus on Easter Sunday. The Bible does not mention Ash Wednesday or the custom of Lent; however, the practice of repentance and mourning in ashes is found in 2 Samuel 13:19, Esther 4:1, Job 2:8, Daniel 9:3 and Matthew 11:21. The ashes to be used at this service are from the burned palms from last year's Palm Sunday Service. The palms were burned by Rick, Cindy and River.

THE LENTEN SEASON

Lent is the 40 days before Easter. During this time, the people of God are called to commemorate and reflect on the Lord's passion through spiritual preparation, conversion and penance. This Holy Season is an invitation to renew our baptismal call...to live as sons and daughters of God and disciples of Christ, our Lord and Savior. It is a time for self-examination and reflection.
