

Reformation Sunday

- L. Your word, O Lord, is eternal; it stands firm in the heavens.
- C. Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light for my path.
- L. Jesus said, "If you hold to my teaching, you are really my disciples."
- C. "Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free."

LUTHER ON SCRIPTURE

- L. Dedicated to the Bible as the source of all the church's teachings, Luther spoke often of the supremacy of the Scriptures in the church's life. "The Christian church is God's servant. It listens to and does nothing but what it knows to be God's Word and command."

GOD'S GRACE ALONE!

- L. For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son,
- C. That whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.
- L. For it is by grace that you have been saved, through faith--and this is not from yourselves,
- C. It is the gift of God!

LUTHER ON GRACE

- L. For Luther, no Scriptural teaching mattered more than the theology of grace. He said, "A good song may well be sung often. Grace consists of this, that God is merciful to us, shows grace for the sake of the Lord Christ, forgives all sins, and will not charge them to us for eternal death. This is grace; the forgiveness of sins for the sake of the Lord Christ, the covering up of sins."

FAITH ALONE!

- L. For in the Gospel a righteousness from God is revealed, a righteousness that is by faith from first to last, just as it is written:
- C. The righteous will live by faith.
- L. Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.
- C. Through whom we have gained access by faith into this grace in which we now stand.

LUTHER ON FAITH

- L. Luther spoke for the truth which comes to us only through faith--not through the good works we accomplish. "It is the will and pleasure of God that whoever sees the Son and believes in Him has eternal life."

THE INVITATION TO REFORMATION

- L. Word Alone! Grace Alone! Faith Alone! These are the touchstones of the Reformation. They are truths for all Christians. In our celebration, let us not praise famous people, but rather let us praise He who is Lord of the Church, Christ, our Savior. He has raised up for us the truth of the Gospel, which burns within each of us. He has graced us with the fire of the Spirit, and that burning will continue to reform and renew the church.

FIRST LESSON: Revelation 14:6-7

⁶I saw another angel flying directly overhead, with an eternal gospel to proclaim to those who dwell on earth, to every nation and tribe and language and people.

⁷And he said with a loud voice, "Fear God and give him glory, because the hour of his judgment has come, and worship him who made heaven and earth, the sea and the springs of water."

PSALM 46

¹God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble.

²Therefore we will not fear, though the earth be moved, and though the mountains be toppled into the depths of the sea;

³Though its waters rage and foam,

and though the mountains tremble at its tumult.

⁴The Lord of hosts is with us;

the God of Jacob is our stronghold.

⁵There is a river whose streams make glad the city of God, the holy habitation of the Most High.

⁶God is in the midst of her; she shall not be overthrown; God shall help her at the break of day.

⁷The nations make much ado, and the kingdoms are shaken; God has spoken, and the earth shall melt away.

⁸The Lord of hosts is with us;

the God of Jacob is our stronghold.

SECOND LESSON: Romans 3:19-28

¹⁹Now we know that whatever the law says it speaks to those who are under the law, so that every mouth may be stopped, and the whole world may be held accountable to God. ²⁰For by works of the law no human being will be justified in his sight, since through the law comes knowledge of sin. ²¹But now the righteousness of God has been manifested apart from the law, although the Law and the Prophets bear witness to it — ²²the righteousness of God through faith in Jesus Christ for all who believe. For there is no distinction: ²³for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, ²⁴and are justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, ²⁵whom God put forward as a propitiation by his blood, to be received by faith. This was to show God's righteousness, because in his divine forbearance he had passed over former sins. ²⁶It was to show his righteousness at the present time, so that he might be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus. ²⁷Then what becomes of our boasting? It is excluded. By what kind of law? By a law of works? No, but by the law of faith. ²⁸For we hold that one is justified by faith apart from works of the law.

THE HOLY GOSPEL: John 8:31-36

³¹Jesus said to the Jews who had believed him, "If you abide in my word, you are truly my disciples, ³²and you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free." ³³They answered him, "We are offspring of Abraham and have never been enslaved to anyone. How is it that you say, 'You will become free'?" ³⁴Jesus answered them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, everyone who practices sin is a slave to sin. ³⁵The slave does not remain in the house forever; the son remains forever. ³⁶So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed."
