## The Lighting of the Advent Candles: We Light the Candle of Love

- L: We have lit the candles of hope, peace and joy so far in our Advent journey to remind us of God's gifts of hope, peace and joy that bring light to our darkness. Today is the fourth Sunday of Advent and we light the Candle of love. With this flame we signify the love of God that surrounds and fills us at all times, which we recognize in a special way in the Christmas story. There is no greater power than love. It is stronger than rulers and empires, stronger than grief or despair, stronger even than death. We love, because God loves us.
- C: Jesus shows us God's perfect love. He is God's perfect love in human form. Those who believe in him and live in him, live in love. Love transforms and perfects all things. It never ends.
- L: Jesus calls us to walk in His love and to love one another as He loves us.
- C: Beloved, let us love, not just in word or speech, but in truth and action. By our love, the world will know that we are disciples of Christ.

We sing "A Candle is Burning" (tune: Away in a Manger) as we light the Candle of Peace

A candle is burning, a candle of love, a candle to point us to heaven above, A baby for Christmas, a wonderful birth, for Jesus is bringing God's love to our earth.

L: Let us pray -- O God of Love, Emmanuel, send your light into our hearts at this time. Help us to be ready for the time of Christ's appearing. Grant that we may so dwell in him that His perfect love fills our entire being. Bless our worship as we celebrate your love and are made ready to show that love to the whole world - both today - and forevermore; in Jesus' name. **Amen.**

#### FIRST LESSON: Micah 5:2-5a

<sup>2</sup>But you, O Bethlehem Ephrathah, who are too little to be among the clans of Judah, from you shall come forth for me one who is to be ruler in Israel, whose coming forth is from of old, from ancient days. <sup>3</sup>Therefore he shall give them up until the time when she who is in labor has given birth; then the rest of his brothers shall return to the people of Israel. <sup>4</sup>And he shall stand and shepherd his flock in the strength of the Lord, in the majesty of the name of the Lord his God. And they shall dwell secure, for now he shall be great to the ends of the earth. <sup>5</sup>And he shall be their peace.

### **PSALM 80:1-7**

<sup>1</sup>Hear, O Shepherd of Israel, leading Joseph like a flock; shine forth, you that are enthroned upon the cherubim.

<sup>2</sup>In the presence of Ephraim, Benjamin, and Manasseh, stir up your strength and come to help us.

<sup>3</sup>Restore us, O God of hosts; show the light of your countenance, and we shall be saved.

<sup>4</sup>O Lord God of hosts,

how long will you be angered despite the prayers of your people?

<sup>5</sup>You have fed them with the bread of tears; you have given them bowls of tears to drink.

<sup>6</sup>You have made us the derision of our neighbors, and our enemies laugh us to scorn.

<sup>7</sup>Restore us, O God of hosts; show the light of your countenance, and we shall be saved.

#### SECOND LESSON: 1 John 4:7-12

<sup>7</sup>Dear friends, let us continue to love one another, for love comes from God. Anyone who loves is a child of God and knows God. <sup>8</sup>But anyone who does not love does not know God, for God is love <sup>9</sup>God showed how much he loved us by sending his one and only Son into the world so that we might have eternal life through him. <sup>10</sup>This is real love—not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as a sacrifice to take away our sins. <sup>11</sup>Dear friends, since God loved us that much, we surely ought to love each other. <sup>12</sup>No one has ever seen God. But if we love each other, God lives in us, and his love is brought to full expression in us.

#### THE HOLY GOSPEL: Matthew 1:18-25

<sup>18</sup>Now the birth of Jesus Christ took place in this way. When his mother Mary had been betrothed to Joseph, before they came together she was found to be with child from the Holy Spirit. <sup>19</sup>And her husband Joseph, being a just man and unwilling to put her to shame, resolved to divorce her quietly. <sup>20</sup>But as he considered these things, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, saying, "Joseph, son of David, do not fear to take Mary as your wife, for that which is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit. <sup>21</sup>She will bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins." <sup>22</sup>All this took place to fulfill what the Lord had spoken by the prophet: <sup>23</sup>"Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and they shall call his name Immanuel" (which means, God with us). <sup>24</sup>When Joseph woke from sleep, he did as the angel of the Lord commanded him: he took his wife, <sup>25</sup>but knew her not until she had given birth to a son. And he called his name Jesus.
