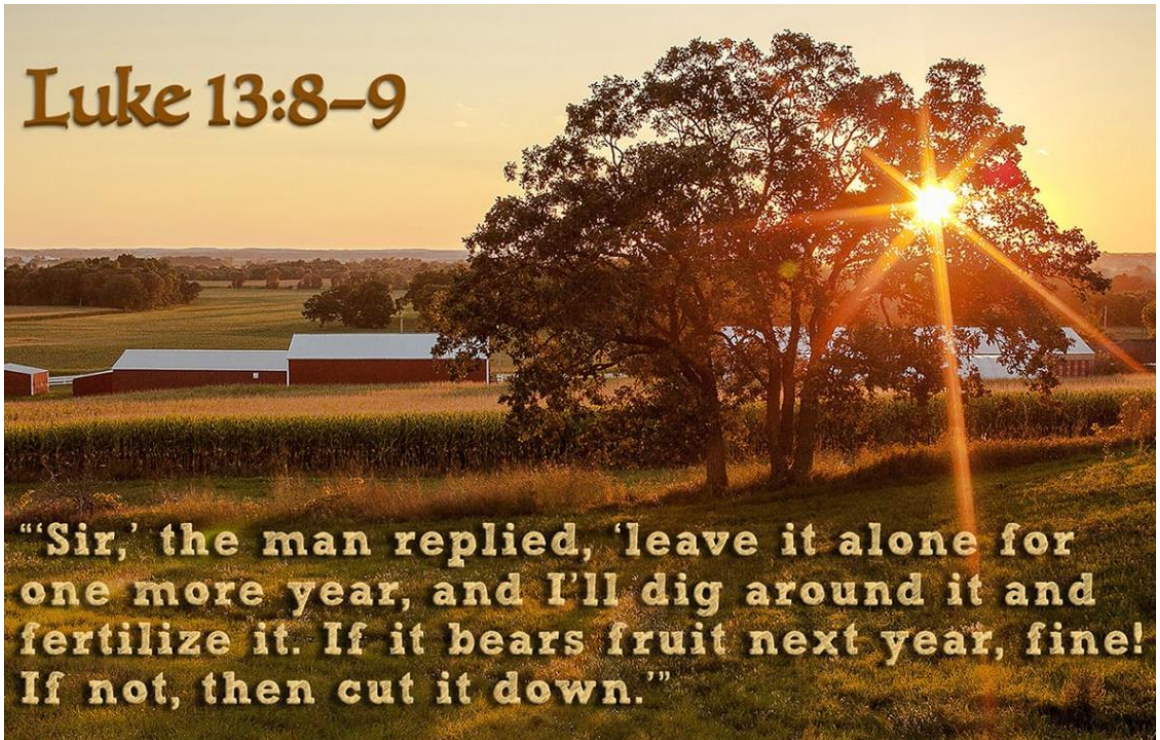

**FIRST READING: Isaiah 5: 1-7**

Let me sing for my beloved my love song concerning his vineyard: My beloved had a vineyard on a very fertile hill. <sup>2</sup> He dug it and cleared it of stones, and planted it with choice vines; he built a watchtower in the midst of it, and hewed out a wine vat in it; and he looked for it to yield grapes, but it yielded wild grapes.<sup>3</sup> And now, O inhabitants of Jerusalem and men of Judah, judge between me and my vineyard.<sup>4</sup> What more was there to do for my vineyard, that I have not done in it? When I looked for it to yield grapes, why did it yield wild grapes?<sup>5</sup> And now I will tell you what I will do to my vineyard. I will remove its hedge, and it shall be devoured; I will break down its wall, and it shall be trampled down.<sup>6</sup> I will make it a waste; it shall not be pruned or hoed, and briars and thorns shall grow up; I will also command the clouds that they rain no rain upon it. <sup>7</sup> For the vineyard of

the Lord of hosts is the house of Israel, and the men of Judah are his pleasant planting; and he looked for justice, but behold, bloodshed; for righteousness, but behold, an outcry!

### **Psalm 85: 1-13**

<sup>1</sup> Lord, you were favorable to your land; you restored the fortunes of Jacob.

<sup>2</sup>**You forgave the iniquity of your people; you covered all their sin.**

<sup>3</sup>You withdrew all your wrath; you turned from your hot anger.

<sup>4</sup>**Restore us again, O God of our salvation, and put away your indignation toward us!**

<sup>5</sup>Will you be angry with us forever? Will you prolong your anger to all generations?

<sup>6</sup>**Will you not revive us again, that your people may rejoice in you?**

<sup>7</sup>Show us your steadfast love, O Lord, and grant us your salvation.

<sup>8</sup>**Let me hear what God the Lord will speak, for he will speak peace to his people, to his saints; but let them not turn back to folly.**

<sup>9</sup>Surely his salvation is near to those who fear him, that glory may dwell in our land.

<sup>10</sup>**Steadfast love and faithfulness meet; righteousness and peace kiss each other.**

<sup>11</sup>Faithfulness springs up from the ground, and righteousness looks down from the sky.

<sup>12</sup>**Yes, the Lord will give what is good, and our land will yield its increase.**

<sup>13</sup>Righteousness will go before him and make his footsteps a way.

### **Second Reading: Colossians 1:3-14**

<sup>3</sup> We always thank God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, when we pray for you, <sup>4</sup> since we heard of your faith in Christ Jesus and of the love that you have for all the saints, <sup>5</sup> because of the hope laid up for you in heaven. Of this you have heard before in the word of the truth, the gospel, <sup>6</sup> which has come to you, as indeed in the whole world it is *bearing fruit and increasing*—as it also does among you, since the day you heard it and understood the grace of God in truth, <sup>7</sup> just as you learned it from Epaphras our beloved fellow servant. He is a faithful minister of Christ on your behalf <sup>8</sup> and has made known to us your love in the Spirit. <sup>9</sup> And so, from the day we heard, we have not ceased to pray for you, asking that you may be filled with the knowledge of his will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding, <sup>10</sup> *so as to walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing to him: bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God*; <sup>11</sup> being strengthened with all power, according to his glorious might, for all endurance and patience with joy; <sup>12</sup> giving thanks<sup>[d]</sup> to the Father, who has qualified you<sup>[e]</sup> to share in the inheritance of the saints in light. <sup>13</sup> He has

delivered us from the domain of darkness and transferred us to the kingdom of his beloved Son, <sup>14</sup> in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.

<sup>1</sup>There were some present at that very time who told {Jesus} about the Galileans whose blood Pilate had mingled with their sacrifices. <sup>2</sup>And he answered them, “Do you think that these Galileans were worse sinners than all the other Galileans, because they suffered in this way? <sup>3</sup>No, I tell you; but unless you repent, you will all likewise perish. <sup>4</sup>Or those eighteen on whom the tower in Siloam fell and killed them: do you think that they were worse offenders than all the others who lived in Jerusalem? <sup>5</sup>No, I tell you; but unless you repent, you will all likewise perish.” <sup>6</sup>And he told this parable: “A man had a fig tree planted in his vineyard, and he came seeking fruit on it and found none. <sup>7</sup>And he said to the vinedresser, ‘Look, for three years now I have come seeking fruit on this fig tree, and I find none. Cut it down. Why should it use up the ground?’ <sup>8</sup>And he answered him, ‘Sir, let it alone this year also, until I dig around it and put on manure. <sup>9</sup>Then if it should bear fruit next year, well and good; but if not, you can cut it down.’”
