"Filled with the Holy Spirit, Stepping Out in Faith!"

Joshua 1:9 "The Lord spoke to Joshua: Be strong and courageous; do not be frightened or dismayed, for the LORD your God is with you wherever you go." The word "graduate" means "step." So a graduate is a person who has completed another step or milestone in their journey in preparation to take the next step.

During this month many will be remembering and congratulating graduates. The word graduate literally means "Step." So a graduate is a person who has completed another step or milestone in their journey in preparation to take the next step. May we congratulate and pray for the graduates in our lives as they complete this step and prepare in faith to take the next step. You may not be a graduate, but we are all taking steps of faith to follow our Lord Jesus. Like Joshua, remember that God is with you, to give you courage, strength and faith to step out in faith to live out your calling. Remember that Christ is with you through the power of the Holy Spirit who will guide you in the Word so that you will be blessed to be a blessing!

This month we transition from Easter to the Season of Pentecost which begins with the Day of Pentecost. The Day of Pentecost is when we celebrate God's gift of the Holy Spirit that brought the Church to life and empowered the Church to *step out in faith* to become witnesses of Christ in word and deed. Now filled with the Holy Spirit, the Church took an important step of faith to answer God's calling in Christ to be the Church (ecclesia in Greek which means "the called-out ones.") The disciples and early Church could not have done this on their own apart from the power of God made available to them in the gift of the Holy Spirit. This month we celebrate fathers/Godly men who are taking important *steps of faith* as the Spirit leads and empowers them to be a blessing to their families!

In the Old Testament, God encouraged and empowered His people to make an important step of faith. In Joshua 1, the Lord speaks empowering words to Joshua as he is called to assume a very important and demanding role: filling the shoes of Moses as Joshua prepares to lead the people into the promised land. God calls Joshua to meditate on God's Word and to be obedient to it as God promises to never fail or forsake Joshua and God's people. Chapter one ends with Joshua assuming leadership and calling the people of God to step out in faith as they prepare to cross the Jordan and face the challenges and blessings ahead. God gave Joshua great courage for a great calling! You can read about the mighty acts that God did through Joshua in the book of Joshua. The book closes with Joshua's farewell address in chapter 24 as he prepares to die. He encourages the people to remain faithful to the Lord and serve Him with sincerity. He lifts up himself and his family as an example: "But as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord!" Like Joshua, I would like to encourage all fathers and Godly men to step out in faith and to live out their call to be a role model of Christ-like faith and love. God bless our fathers and Godly men, especially this month, as they are recognized on Father's Day, June 15! A Happy and Blessed Father's Day to you!

In the Acts of the Apostles (some have said that the title ought to be The Acts of the Holy Spirit) we read how the disciples needed courage and confidence to step out in faith. The risen Lord Jesus appeared to them and gave them new life, hope and the assurance of salvation. However, Jesus would no longer be with them in His bodily form as He would ascend to the Father, but he did promise to send the Holy Spirit. On the day of Pentecost the Holy Spirit filled the disciples and believers and the Church was born. The presence and power of God in the Holy Spirit gave the disciples and the Church new courage and confidence to step out in faith and be the Church as they proclaimed the gospel in word and deed. As we are filled with the power of the Holy Spirit at Grace, we too can be courageous and confident in our faith and in our calling to share the love of God in Christ Jesus. On June 8, the Day of Pentecost, we will celebrate the gift of the Holy Spirit for all of God's people. In Holy Baptism we celebrate the gift of the Holy Spirit and the new life, forgiveness and salvation that God brings in the gift of the Spirit.

This month Grace will host the Community VBS "The Armor of God," Sunday, June 1 – Thursday, June 5 (see announcement for details). We will also host the NALC Solid Rock Day Camp Monday, June 16-Friday, June 21. (See announcement). As we step out in faith to disciple our young people, let us be in prayer for these ministries as we ask the Holy Spirit to empower and guide us as we proclaim the Gospel. As we all step out in faith, like Joshua and the early Church, God will guide us in the Holy Spirit and will give us His presence, strength and courage.

June 1, 2025, 7th Sun of Easter (We will also recognize the Ascension of our Lord) Acts 1, and John 17. In John 17, Jesus prays for the Church as he prepares to go to the cross for us. In Acts, Jesus blessed the faithful as He ascended into heaven calling the Church to be God's blessing to the world!

June 8, 2025 *The Day of Pentecost* Acts 2:1-21 John 14:25-31 Pentecost is the birthday of the Church, the day that God sent the promised Holy Spirit upon the faithful. Peter boldly preached the good news and in the Spirit's power, 3,000 came to faith and were baptized.

June 15, 2025, Holy Trinity Sunday, Happy Father's Day Romans 5:1-5, John 16:12-15. We begin our worship in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit as well as baptize and pray in the Triune name of God. This Sunday is set aside to praise and give thanks to the Holy Trinity who creates us, redeems us and sustains us with gifts of grace and love. On this Father's Day let us give thanks for Godly men who put their faith and hope in the one true God and through their life of faith teach their family and others about the love, grace and blessing of our Triune God!

June 22, 2025 2nd Sun after Pentecost: Luke 8:26-39

In the Gospel Jesus and the disciples encounter a demon-possessed man who had been bound by chains and was living in torment in a cemetery. Jesus delivered the man from the demons and sent them into a herd of pigs nearby. The man having experienced new life wanted to follow Jesus however Jesus said, "Return to your home, and declare how much God has done for you."

June 29, 2025, 3rd Sun aft Pentecost, Special Independence Day Service. We will give thanks to God for our country and the freedoms and blessings we enjoy as Americans but more importantly as God's people in Christ. We will sing traditional national hymns as well as honor our service men and women. Galatians 5:1,13-22, John 8:31-36.


